Dinner will consist of Homemade Rock Springs BBQ, Cole Slaw, Cowboy Beans, Iced Tea, Water, and Lemonade, and WORLD-FAMOUS ROCK SPRINGS PIE.

Important note for this year’s Annual Meeting Attendee’s

Members are urged to attend the **Annual Membership Meeting** and stay over for the festivities however meeting seating will coincide with pre-paid and reserved dinner guests so please vacate your seat to allow for the paid dinner guests to arrive and set up at their table. It is possible with this year’s turnout, non-reserved dinner guests will not have seating so if you have chosen not to reserve and pay for your dinner, you might have to stand.

Firearms winners: If you are in attendance, you can take your firearm with you by furnishing a completed ASRPA Transfer form and current Arizona CCW permit copy. If you do not have a current Arizona CCW Permit, you can also have us ship the firearm to an FFL of your choice to process the transfer. We will only pay for shipping to firearms dealers in State. If you are out of state you will need to pay for shipping to your FFL, which is usually around \$25.
