1. RANGE LOCATION: The Ben Avery (Black Canyon) Shooting Range, 25 mi. North of Phoenix, AZ. ¹/₂ mile West of I-17 on the Carefree Hwy. (Exit 223).

- 2. FACILITIES: A Camping area, with electricity, water & toilet facilities is available, during the matches, for competitors only. Soft drinks are available, but bring your own lunch.
- 3. RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules shall apply.
- 4. ELIGIBILITY: All competitors must be paid up members of the ASR&PA. (\$25.00 for adults, \$10.00 for juniors). If a competitor does not wish to join the ASR&PA he/she may pay a \$5.00 match membership fee. All competitors must show their membership card at the stat office when they are obtaining their squadding or pay the 5.00 match membership fee.
- 5. ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED: All entries must be paid in advance.

6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry in individual events on enclosed Registration & Entry form (include NRA Membership ID#). Entries MUST be accompanied by check or money order made payable to ASR&PA, HP Div. Mail to Middleton Tompkins, P.O. Box 11684, Prescott, AZ 86304. Phone: (602) 618-4041. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee, providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00PM, Monday, 1 April 2024. There will be no refunds for those canceling after that time. You may also enter on line at Desert Sharpshooters.com.

- 7. ENTRIES CLOSE: 6:00 PM Monday, 1 April 2024. Entries after this time are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only. An additional \$20.00 will be charged for late entries.
- 8. ENTRY LIMITS: 150 Individual entries.

Reminder: Everyone who is not a current paid up member of the ASR&PA must select one of the following options:

a. Those wishing to be a member of the ASR&PA may do so by submitting appropriate fees (\$25.00 for adults; \$10.00 for juniors).

OR

b. Those not wishing to be a member of the ASR&PA must pay a \$5.00 one time match membership fee.

LATE ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 in addition to appropriate match fee.

CHALLENGE FEE: \$1.00 The challenge fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.

10. PRACTICE FIRING: There will be no practice firing before the match.

- 11. TARGETS: MR-63, MR-65, MR-1
- 12. TARGET SERVICE: Competitors will pull their own targets.
- 13. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): Approved NRA empty chamber indicators are required to be used at all times except during the preparation time and firing of their relay. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the stat. office for \$1.50 each.
- 14. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the Stat. Office starting at approx. 7:00 AM Friday14 April, Saturday 15 April, and Sunday16 April. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding ticket by 7:30 AM will only be squadded to fill up vacancies. Classification Cards must be shown before squadding tickets will be issued.
- 15. SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified. The alternate scoring system will be used for safety reasons.
- 16. CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Rule 19.6 "Assigned Classification" maybe used. Those unclassified or without proof of classification, will be required to compete in the Master class. Please indicate classification on the registration & entry form.
- 17. DIVISION BY RIFLE: Matches #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #7, #8, #9, #10 & #11 Any Rifle (Division A), Palma Rifle (Division P), Service Rifle (Division S), F-Open (Division O), F-TR (Division T), Scope Only (Division F).
- NOTE: Individuals must fire the same rifle in all of the matches. Anyone changing rifles will be placed in the higher division.
- 18. CATEGORIES: (Fri., Sat, & Sun) Service, (Includes Reserve, and National Guard) and Civilian.
- 19. AWARDS: Monetary awards or trophies will be awarded to Match Winners and individuals in each Division Category/Class award group on Saturday & Sunday. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc. awards will be given based on one award for each seven (7) competitors, i.e. second 8-14, third 15-21, etc.

SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In match #11a High Junior, Woman, Senior, and Grand Senior award will be given if there are 5 or more entries.

20. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends 1/2 hour after the posting of the match results.

21. RESULTS BULLETINS: Results bulletins will only be mailed to those people requesting them. The match results will be posted on the Desert Sharpshooters web site.

- MATCH 5: 600 yds. slow fire prone, iron sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR 63 target.
