1. RANGE LOCATION: The Ben Avery (Black Canyon) Shooting Range, 25 mi. North of Phoenix, AZ. ½ mile West of I-17 on the Carefree Hwy. (Exit 223).
2. FACILITIES: A Camping area, with electricity, water & toilet facilities are available, during the matches, for competitors only. Soft drinks are available but bring your own lunch.
3. RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules shall apply.
4. ELIGIBILITY: All competitors must be paid members of the ASR&PA. (\$25.00 for adults, \$10.00 for juniors). If a competitor does not wish to join the ASR&PA he/she may pay a \$10.00 match membership fee. **All competitors must show their membership card at the stat office when they are obtaining their squadding or pay the \$10.00 match membership fee.**
5. ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED: All entries must be paid for in advance.
6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry in individual events on enclosed Registration & Entry form (include NRA Membership ID#).
Paper entries **MUST** be accompanied by a check or money order made payable ASR&PA, HP Div. Mail to Middleton Tompkins, STE 822 3120 W Carefree Highway Phoenix, AZ 85086. Phone: (602) 618-4041. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee, providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00PM, Monday, 7 April 2025. There will be no refunds for those cancellations after that time. You may also enter online at Desert Sharpshooters.com.
7. ENTRIES CLOSE: 6:00 PM Monday, 7 April 2025. Entries after this time are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only. An additional \$20.00 will be charged for late entries.
8. ENTRY LIMITS: 150 Individual entries.
9. FEES: All individual matches
Sat. & Sun adults \$75.00
Saturday **or** Sunday **only** adults \$40.00
Friday DSS 600-yard **standalone** Match \$40.00.

Military teams must make advance arrangements to pay match fees.

Reminder: Everyone who is not a current paid up member of the ASR&PA must select one of the following options:

a. Those wishing to be an **Annual** member of the ASR&PA may do so by submitting appropriate fees (\$25.00 for adults; \$10.00 for juniors).

OR

b. Those not wishing to be a member of the ASR&PA must pay a \$10.00 one-time **match** membership fee.

LATE ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 in addition to appropriate match fee.

CHALLENGE FEE: \$1.00 The fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.

10. PRACTICE FIRING: There will be no practice firing before the match.

11. TARGETS: MR-63/63FC, MR-65/65FC, MR-1/MR1FC

12. TARGET SERVICE: Competitors **will pull** their own targets.

13. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): Approved NRA empty chamber indicators are required to be always used except during the preparation time and firing of their relay. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the stat. office for \$1.50 each.

14. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the Stat office starts at approx. 7:00 AM Friday 11 April, Saturday 12 April, and Sunday 13 April. 2025 A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding ticket by 7:30 AM will only be squadded to fill up vacancies. Classification Cards must be shown before squadding tickets are issued.

15. SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified. The alternate scoring system will be used for safety reasons.

16. CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Rule 19.6 "Assigned Classification" may be used. Those unclassified or without proof of classification, will be required to compete in the Master class. Please indicate classification on the registration & entry form.

17. DIVISION BY RIFLE: Matches #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #7.

Any/Any Rifle (Division A), Palma Rifle (Division P), Service Rifle (Division S), F-Open (Division O), F-TR (Division T).

NOTE: Individuals must fire the same rifle in all the matches. Anyone changing rifles will be placed in the higher division.

18. CATEGORIES: (Fri., Sat, & Sun) Service, Civilian.

19. AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd Match Winners in each Division Category/Class award group on Sunday. Monetary award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors, or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc. awards will be given based on one award for each of the seven (7) competitors, i.e. second 8-14, third 15-21, etc.

SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In match #1a to the High Junior.

20. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends 1/2 hour after the posting of the match results.

21. RESULTS BULLETINS: Results bulletins will only be mailed to those people requesting them. The match results will be posted on the Desert Sharpshooters web site.

MATCH 2a: 600 yds. slow fire prone, **2** sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR1/MR1FC target.

MATCH 3a: 600 yds. slow fire prone, **NO** sighters & 20 shots for record, 20 minutes. MR1/MR1FC target.

Saturday, 12 April. 2025, 8:00 AM

MATCH 1: 300yds. Slow fire prone, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR63/MR63FC target.

MATCH 2: 500 yds. slow fire prone, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR65/MR65FC target.

MATCH 3: 600 yds. slow fire prone, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR1/MR1FC target.

Sunday, 13 April. 2025, 8:00 AM

MATCH 4: 300yds. slow fire prone, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR63/MR63FC target.

MATCH 5: 500 yds. slow fire prone, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR65/MR65FC target.

MATCH 6: 600 yds. slow fire prone, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR1/MR1FC target.

MATCH 7: Arizona State Midrange Championship: An aggregate of scores fired in matches #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6.
